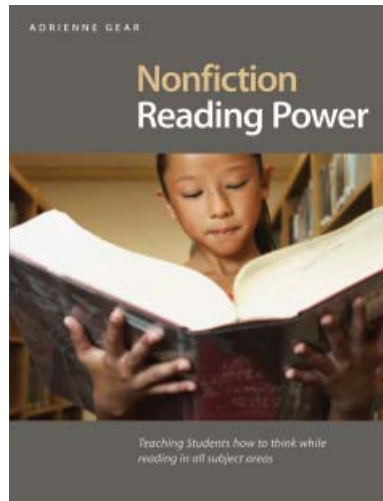
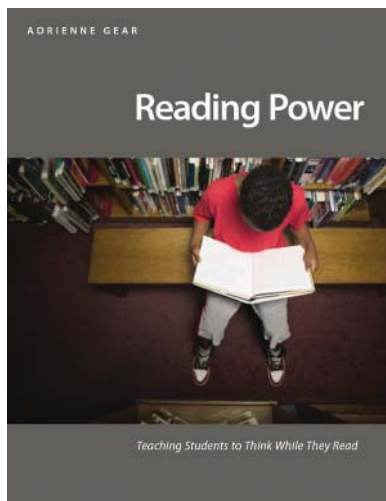


Adrienne Gear's **TOP PICKS** to Help Students Think While They Read
