
Five Finger Rule!

- 1. Open your book to the middle
- 2. Open up your hand.
- 3. Read a page of the book to yourself
- 4. Put down one finger each time you find a tricky word.
- 5. If your thumb is still up at the end of the page, it is probably a good book for you!



Nine P's Reading

- 1. **P**ick a book.
- 2. Practise reading it.
- 3. **P**ick a partner.
- 4. Plan how you and your partner will read.
- 5. \mathbf{P} lace yourselves hip to hip so you can both see the books.
- 6. \mathbf{P} resent your reading of the book or part of the book to your partner.
- 7. \mathbf{P} olitely listen to your partner read.
- 8. **P**raise each other's reading.
- 9. Put your books away where they belong.
