

# The S2-P2-C2 Strategy

Use the S2-P2-C2 strategy every time you write and need a finished product. Check off each component as you review it.

## Sentences

- Do my sentences have varied beginnings and lengths?
- Are all sentences correctly composed with complete subjects and predicates?
- Have I avoided run-on sentences and sentence fragments?

## Spelling

- Is my spelling correct?
- Have I used a thesaurus for “better” words, spelled correctly?

## Paragraphs

- Is each paragraph indented?
- Is there one main idea per paragraph?
- Does each paragraph flow into the next?
- Is there interesting information in each paragraph?
- Does each paragraph stick to the point?

## Punctuation

- Does each sentence contain correct punctuation? (For example, direct quotations are set within double quotation marks.)

## Catchy start

- Does the beginning hook the reader?
- Does it make sense with what’s to come?

## Conclusion

- Does the conclusion tie it all up and flow with what’s happened?
- Does it relate back to the beginning or, because of its clever content, leave the reader wondering and even wanting more?
