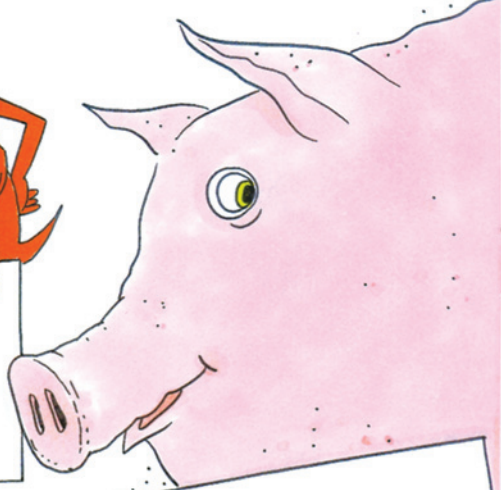

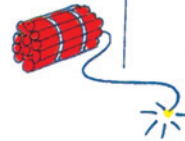

Hints and Answers

Part of the fun of word games is that there are many "right" answers. Here are some of the answers; yours might be different. You may even find answers we didn't think of.

Fickle Pickle (pages 4-5) — **spy**: pie, eye, butterfly, die, necktie, sky, "Y"; **thin**: pin, fish fin, tin, twin, skin, chin, grin; **fickle**: pickle, nickel, sickle; **sing**: king, sling, string, ring, wing, sting; **wee**: tea, bee, "3", tree, pea, "V", "T", knee; **soon**: loon, balloon, spoon, moon, June, raccoon; **knock**: wok, rock, clock, sock; lock, crock; **hoot**: boot, root, parachute, fruit.

Rhyme Time (pages 6-7) — tire fire; cut nut; boil oil; long song; fake lake; splash trash; damp stamp; rattle battle; stuck truck; brain strain; met vet; last blast; sly fly; far star; night flight; ticket wicket; fatter batter; lighter fighter; mean queen; snake's aches, Bill's pills; awful waffle; ocean motion; wrote note.

Scrambled Words (pages 22-23) — **Animals**: bird, fish, snake, tiger, seal, lion, turtle, giraffe, elephant, monkey, lamb, rabbit. **Vegetables**: potato, carrot, peas, celery, lettuce, parsnip, turnip, zucchini, eggplant, spinach, broccoli, beans, onion. **Fruits**: plum, tomato, apple, grapes, pear, kiwi, orange, pineapple, watermelon, strawberry, cherry.
